A. THE **COMPASSION** OF JESUS (*Mark 8:1-3*)

1. *“During those days” –*
2. *“another large crowd gathered” –*
3. *“Jesus called His disciples to Him” –*
4. *“I have compassion” –*
5. *“they have been with me for three days” –*
6. *“they will collapse along the way” –*

B. THE **PROVISION** OF JESUS (*Mark 8:4-7*)

1. *“But where in this remote place...” –*

THE OBVIOUS QUESTION – Have you forgotten what took place a few months back?

2. *“How many loaves do you have?” –*
3. *“gave them to His disciples” –*

SIDE NOTE – For Jewish people to eat with Gentiles was forbidden by rabbinic tradition. This was another reminder how far the gospel would reach.

C. THE **SATISFACTION** OF JESUS (*Mark 8:8-10*)

1. *“The people ate and were satisfied” –*
2. *“the disciples picked up seven basketfuls” –*
3. *“having sent them away” –*
4. *“went to the region of Dalmanutha” –*

Conclusion –

The feeding of the 4000 is the same scenario but very different from the feeding of the 5000 thousand. We all need to remember that God can do the same miracles twice, and that He who provided in the past can also provide in the present.
