- 1. His hopeless condition
 - a. "A man with leprosy"
 - physically suffering -
 - socially isolated -
 - emotionally scarred -
 - spiritually abandoned -
- 2. His desperate plea
 - a. "begged Him on his knees" –
- 3. His determined faith
 - a. "If you are willing, you can make me clean"

 - a. "Don't tell anyone" –
 - b. "Go show yourself to the priest" -
